[2 a ii] Children with chronic illnesses

MHYFVic advocates that all medical services dealing with children who have chronic medical illnesses should observe best management criteria which include:

- Optimal medical care of the particular disorder (protocols apply)
- Psychosocial assessment of child and family
- Appropriate social supports and therapeutic interventions
- Full information about the disorder and about reliable e-Health sources
- Engagement of the family in "ownership" of the management plan
- Service delivery that fosters empathy and trust

Basic and advanced medical training should emphasise these wider criteria beyond the protocols for disease treatment.

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
