MHYFVic advocates that the Commonwealth Government upgrades its migrant support programs to ensure appropriate housing, income support and social integration supports are systematically provided for as long as necessary to assure successful acculturation.

MHYFVic advocates that all area mental health services implement selective 'Culturally and Linguistically Diverse Client Programs', involving cultural awareness training of staff and use of language translation assistance.

MHYFVic advocates promotion of community-based cultural support groups to assist in acculturation of migrants.
