[5 b] Private practitioners and Community Mental Health services.

MHYFVic advocates that specialist mental health assessment and treatment should only be undertaken by professionals who have been adequately trained by accredited training programs covering a sufficient range of evidence-based therapies.

MHYFVic advocates that treatment should only be undertaken after an adequate bio-psycho-social assessment and appropriately formulated management plan.

MHYFVic advocates that Medicare funding should support provision of a treatment program commensurate with clinical standards.

MHYFVic advocates that Intake/Assessment and short-term treatment should be undertaken in Tier Two Community Mental Health services by specialists from Tier Three services.

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
