## [8 a ] Residential services

MHYFVic advocates that every Health Region should have three Residential Treatment Centres associated with its regional child and adolescent mental health service, one for adolescents of secondary school age, one for younger children of primary school age, and a family admissions unit that can treat pre-school children as well as other children within their family groups.

MHYFVic advocates that Juvenile Justice and Child Protection services incorporate properly constituted Residential Treatment Units within their facilities.

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
